



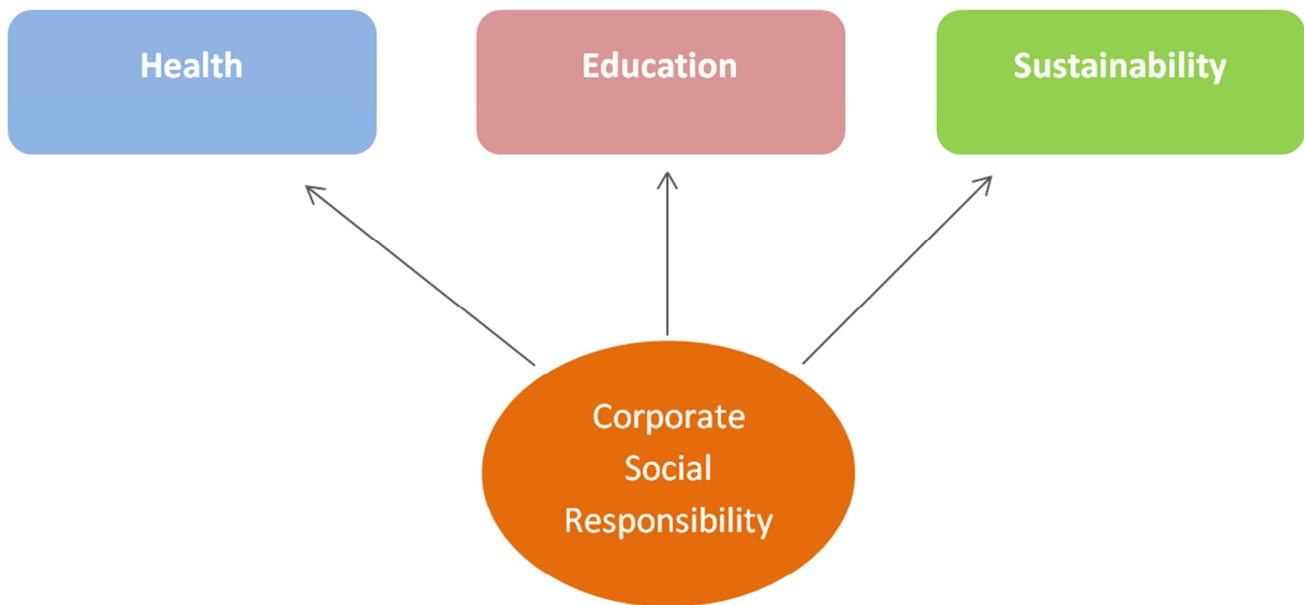

1. With a baseline reading assessment conducted by United Way, CMI FPE was instrumental in conducting the below activities:

2. CMI FPE also setup a fully equipped playground for the Raigad Zilla Parishad School, Panvel so as to encourage children for improved physical activities.





- 3. CMI FPE understands the need of clean drinking water and has provided 7 Anganwadis with 27litres water filter each which does not need electricity.



- 4. CMI FPE has provided of sturdy garden benches for the use of senior citizens in Jambhulpada gram Panchayat.
- 5. To encourage children to explore Mumbai city with a different perspective, Mumbai Museum pamphlets have been introduced in easy to read styles in Hindi, Marathi and English (500 each). These will be distributed to schools after the summer vacation.
