**Rations and Medicines** for covid relief has also been provided throughout the year to the **200 tribal families** in and around Hedavali. These 545 kits consist of Rice, Wheat, Pulses, Cooking Oil, Salt, Sugar, Tea powder, Spices, Peanuts and Multivitamins. The local Primary Health Care centre has been equipped with an X-Ray machine to ensure diagnostic needs are taken care off for people staying in and around Hedavali.

**Strengthening Infrastructure** – Milind Vidyalaya, the 30 years old boys' school is the only one in the Aarey area. Due to its proximity to the sewer, during monsoon the 2 toilets situated on the ground floor of this school get flooded and is inaccessible. Rebuilding it on a higher floor and modernization of the 2 toilet blocks will now help the school maintain sanitation even during monsoons. The school has 2200 boys from nearby slums and tribal areas of Aarey forest. This activity was completed in partnership with Rotary Club of Powai Charitable Trust.



**Covid Protection** – 3000 Covi-Self Test kits (Rapid Antigen test kits) were distributed to villages close to both our workshops (Taloja & Hedavali).

# [Education]



To provide quality **Education** and Training to 3 underprivileged students (disabilities, rural, tribal, orphan). It was decided to partner with Deepstambh Foundation who are care givers to disabled youth. 1 of our sponsored youth was recently recruited by a nationalized bank.

Creation of Vocational training centre - A digital lab is being set up in the Aarey area to help college students get jobs in call centres/ BPOs. The Milind Vidyalaya school in the area will also be equipped with computers and camera so that teachers can help students through online classes.



## [Environment]



**Plantation** - To help raise the income of the farmers who were affected due to the pandemic and multiple lockdowns, one of the CSR activities conducted was the Plantation Drive through our partner – Rotary Club of Powai Charitable Trust and local implementor – Global Parli.

A total of more than 20,045 horticulture plants/ trees were planted by **32 farmers** in Jawhar, a small rural village in Palghar. Plants/ Trees were selected based on local conditions and necessary training has been given. The local implementor will monitor this activity at regular intervals and help farmers in reaching big markets.

The various plants/ trees planted are Jasmine, Banana, Lemon, Drumstick, Mango, and Custard Apple.
