

## [Health & Sanitation]



The local communities must travel to Alibaug or Panvel for reliable healthcare facilities. Hence DFY has now started weekly OPD services from Monday to Saturday from 9.30am to 5.30pm where local communities have access to free health services and medications. Approximately 4612 villagers have benefitted from this service.

Special camps for Ophthalmology, Dental and Physiotherapy services have been conducted and a total of 3870 beneficiaries received these services.

Sex education awareness sessions were held at the local school and a total of 300 students attended the same. To encourage young children to follow good hygiene techniques, kits containing toothbrush, toothpaste, bath soap and nail cutter were provided to 300 children at the local play school.

JCIL conducted clothes and toys drive internally and in doing so helped 3 tribal villages.
