12 General camps and 6 Ophthalmology camps were conducted a total of 821 and 387 beneficiaries respectively received these services.

WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) sessions were held at the local school and villages. These sessions aimed to impart knowledge about the importance of handwashing with soap and the proper techniques involved. To motivate and encourage the community, free soap distribution took place, emphasizing the significance of incorporating this simple yet effective habit into daily routines.

Plantation – JCIL undertook conventional tree plantation of native trees as one of the sustainable activities under CSR and conducted the drive through our partner – Green Yatra at the campus of SRPF, Talaja.

A total of 3000 horticulture plants/ trees were planted in 1.5 acres of land by our enthusiastic employees. Plants/ Trees were selected based on local conditions and necessary training has been given. Green Yatra will monitor this activity at regular intervals and ensure that the plants are well taken care off.

The various plants/ trees planted are Neem, Karanj, Shisam, Kadamb, Mango, Jackfruit, Jamun, and Mahua.
